Public Comment: M. Mix stressed to need for communication between the municipal entities: Fire department and Colfax/Greenwood Township, to avoid unauthorized expenditures. J.Mosse said firefighters are responding to fires with outdated equipment. He felt if more funds were needed to operate the fire department the public should have that information to better decide how to vote in an upcoming millage election.

Fire Chief's Report: Discussion continued regarding what information should be posted regarding fire runs, on the Townships websites. The Township Clerks will post the reports given by the Fire Chief.

Old Business: Jason contacted the City of Manton about the engineering firm they use, and will complete a map location of perspective dry hydrants in the two townships. The Recovery Ordinance expansion which would include billing for fire department services was discussed and tabled to the July meeting.

New Business: Alex and Rachel Tidey gave a presentation on the Fire Department Auxiliary's "Christmas in July" charity event. This will be held on July 23rd from 11 a.m. to 3p.m. at the fire barn. A family from the community will be sought to help with their Christmas needs. This is the 2nd year for the event, flyers have been distributed throughout the communities to let people know about it.
